**Brandon Corpening, Pharm.D., AAHIVP**

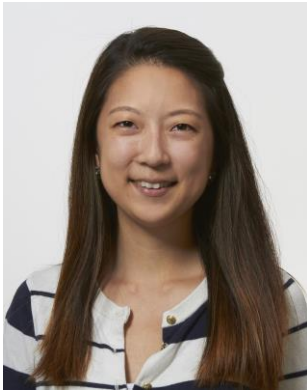

**Kellye Holtgrave, BSPHarm**

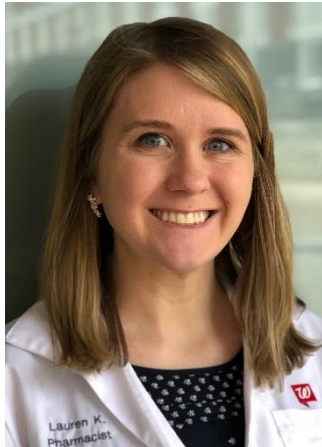
