Center for Career Services and Education

The center provides all students and alumni of UHSP with services that help them explore their careers, build their brand and make connections with future employers

Academic Coaching and Tutoring

We offer individual academic coaching to help you build a comprehensive plan for success. With support from our academic coaching team, you can learn to improve study habits, time management skills and test-taking strategies or learn to manage stress more effectively.

Norton Writing Center

Writing consultants can assist you throughout the writing process and provide constructive feedback to help you improve your writing strategy. The center assists with resume and curriculum vitae development, cover letters and essay writing.

Counseling Services

The Counseling Center provides you with an open, supportive space to speak with a counselor who can help you learn to cope with difficult situations and achieve your goals. Services are confidential, free of charge and are separate from your academic record.

Faculty Mentorship and Guidance

Dedicated to Groundbreaking Research

We believe innovative research is vital to creating healthier societies. Faculty across the University pursue innovative research projects, both in individual laboratories and through UHSP's academic and research centers, with many faculty collaborating with students to introduce them to a variety of projects and methodologies.

Center for Clinical Pharmacology

Established in 2015, the center is a partnership between UHSP and the Department of Anesthesiology at Washington University School of Medicine in St. Louis. The partnership was created to find safer and more effective ways to use prescription medications, and it continues to diversify.

Center for Health Outcomes Research and Education

Established in 2016, the center was established with a mission focused on collaborating with institutions like Washington University School of Medicine in St. Louis, St. Louis University, BJC HealthCare and Express Scripts Inc., to build project-based datasets to support communitywide information exchange and research capacity.

Faculty-Led Research Across Campus

Research conducted by faculty and students spans a variety of interests and specialties. From amphibians and reptiles to MRSA, faculty share their expertise with student researchers expanding their education outside of the classroom and exposing them to the world of bench research.


The North and South Residence

Founded in 1864, St. Louis College of Pharmacy at UHSP is the third-oldest college of pharmacy in the nation and the first college of pharmacy west of the Mississippi River.

For more than 155 years, the college has been preparing students for expert practice and leadership in pharmacy and health professions careers.

Home to our flagship Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.) program, the college offers two points of entry into the program.


