GRADUATION REQUIREMENT FOR TRANSFER STUDENTS

To help ensure a strong academic foundation and meaningful engagement within your chosen major, all undergraduate transfer students are required to complete at least 30 credit hours at UHSP, including a minimum of 18 credit hours in upper-level courses (300-level and above). These residency requirements ensure your degree reflects the depth and quality of a UHSP education while still honoring the work you've already completed.
