

Appendix A

ATSU-CGHS will award students academic credit equal to the successfully earned credits in UHSP's MPH program. Students will not need to complete more than 42 credits to earn their MPH with ATSU-CGHS. An individualized academic degree plan (ADP) will be developed for each UHSP student to ensure all ATSU-CGHS MPH program competencies are covered in each student's cumulative curriculum. The student's ADP will focus on courses within ATSU-CGHS's curriculum that align with incomplete competencies needed to meet program outcomes and will total no more than 42 credit hours.
