

Teach-Out Program Details: Graduate Programs

UHSP's Master of Public Health (MPH) to SLU's Master of Public Health (MPH)

Note: A USHP to SLU-CPHSJ MPH program level cross walk affirmed that the competencies covered in the UHSP foundational PUBH courses appear to align with SLU-CPHSJ MPH foundational courses, as documented in the table below. As some of the competencies covered in the USHP courses are split across specific courses differently than in the SLU-CPHSJ MPH, it is not possible to make a one-to-one transfer; rather, taken as a group of courses, we can accept students into the program with advanced standing with respect to having completed the foundational level intro courses, and be able to finish the MPH by completing the remaining foundational and/or concentration-specific courses, as needed. If a student must complete the MPH online, they would be assigned to the Public Health Practice concentration, which is the only concentration that can be fully met with online courses. If they can complete the program in-person, they may be able to choose among other concentrations (e.g., epidemiology, biostatistics, behavioral science, health management and policy), which could be determined on a case-by-case basis.
